1. Please show up on time to keep pace of play consistent. There are leagues that tee-off after our group. Out of bounds; player may drop, one stroke penalty, no distance penalty, within two club lengths along the flight of the ball. Ball may not end up closer to the hole. Provisional Ball may be played with a one-stroke penalty. The max. Score on any hole is double par. (example: par 4 – Max. score 8) Be considerate to all league players in terms of the pace of play.
2. Substitutes; Responsibility of obtaining an official substitute is that of the player or his teammate. If the substitute doesn't have an established handicap, then we can establish one for him/her with that score. Ideally have him/her call in a score(s) before he/she plays to establish a handicap. Call me in the event that you are having a sub play so I may adjust score cards.
3. Substitutes may participate in the tournament ONLY if they have played in at least two matches in the league. You must have at least one regular player from your team present, otherwise team forfeits that round. You cannot pre-golf for tournament matches, you must be present with your group.
4. We will play from the white tees unless otherwise specified. Seniors (55+) have the option of playing from the gold tees and women have the option of playing from the red tees.
5. Current USGA rules will govern play except that balls may be cleaned at any time. If question arises on a ruling try to discuss it among group.
6. League format is 2 person teams, using a computer generated/unofficial USGA handicap system. Maximum of 20 points per match could be won, two matches going on at same time thus potential 40 points per team. Two points awarded to player winning a hole, one point for EACH player in a tied hole, two points awarded to player with the best net score after subtracting handicap(one point for a tie) and zero points awarded for losing a hole
7. If there is any doubt about course conditions due to the weather please call Arrowhead at 740-965-5422. If a week is cancelled it will be made up at the end of season prior to the 18 hole finale.
8. Feel free to bring your own beverages or snacks and stay around to socialize after your round. For the 18 hole finale week, Big Walnut Grill will provide food. Awards will be given out at this time.
