EXTENSION OF THE  
PROCLAMATION OF STATE OF CIVIL EMERGENCY

ISSUED APRIL 21, 2020

WHEREAS, on March 23, 2020 a State of Civil Emergency was proclaimed pursuant to Chapter 507 of the Worthington Codified Ordinances for the entire City of Worthington to protect the lives and well-being of the citizens of the City as well as those who work, attend school, and visit the City, from the dangerous effects of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, COVID-19 continues to threaten the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Worthington, negatively impact local businesses, and substantially impair the functioning of City government and its ability to protect the lives and property of the citizens of the City of Worthington.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Matthew H. Greeson, City Manager of the City of Worthington, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Ohio Constitution, the Ohio Revised Code, and the Charter and Codified Ordinances of the City of Worthington, do hereby make the following proclamation for the protection of life and property:

The Proclamation of State of Civil Emergency issued on March 23, 2020 is hereby extended for thirty days and shall remain in full force and effect until 11:59 p.m. on May 20, 2020 unless extended, modified, or earlier terminated by the City Manager or by a majority vote of the City Council.

I have signed this Proclamation of State of Civil Emergency on this 21<sup>st</sup> day of April, 2020 in Worthington, Ohio.
