



Use-of-Force Definitions

- **FCJ:** Franklin County Jail
- **Resistant Handcuffing:** This occurs when an arrestee refuses to place their hands behind their backs at the request of an officer. In response, the officer may have to assist the arrestee in placing their hand(s) behind their back in order to be handcuffed.
- **TASER (probes):** Officer used an Electronic Control Device (ECD) on a resistant subject and deployed at least one of two probes on target
- **Assisted to Ground:** Officers assisted a passively resistant subject from a chair and laid prone on the ground while being treated by medics.
- **Joint Manipulation:** Officer used joint manipulation of combative arrestee's left wrist in order to gain compliance and control while effecting an arrest.
- **TASER (warning):** Officer displayed Electronic Control Device (ECD) and warned arrestee that it would be used if they continued to resist.
- **Leg Shackles:** Officers utilized leg shackles to secure the feet and legs of a combative subject that kicked an officer and continued to try and kick officers after being handcuffed.
- **Balance Displacement:** Officers displaced the subject's balance forward while escorting them from a bus that they refused to exit at the request of the driver.
- **Escort:** Officers held onto the subject's arms while removing them from a bus that they refused to exit at the request of the driver.
- **Pressure Point:** Officer used a pressure point control tactic under the nose of a combative subject that was threatening suicide.
