The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) along with its partners the City of Columbus, City of Worthington, Perry Township, Franklin County, and the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC), are studying potential improvements to State Route 161 (SR 161 – also known as Dublin-Granville Road) between Sawmill Road and Olentangy River Road. The purpose of the study is to develop a strategy for improvements that are constructible and fundable. This letter is to inform you that an open house public meeting will be held on **Tuesday, June 6th from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m.** in the Thomas Worthington High School cafeteria located at 300 W.
